Summary:

Needs/Desires:

- More Henry and Clayton County express stops
- Bus shelters
- More regional connectivity (especially in Henry and Clayton Counties)
- Congestion relief from Henry into Clayton County
 - HWY 138
 - 19/41
 - 20/81
 - Mt. Zion (HWY 54) near Clayton State area going south towards McDonough
- Upgrade Cleveland Avenue like North Avenue with bike lanes, medians and synchronized lights
- Faster, safer, seamless transit service
- Transit communication packet to share with staff and clients about existing and future transit options
- Southwood Kaiser campus needs more parking space in their lots—considering incentives to use transit
- Expand MARTA mobility to those who may have greater health concerns but not disability

Major Themes:

- Uber is coming up with a healthcare transport line
